



Grant Guidelines Spring 2018

Grant Type: Center of Wonder Spring Grants

Grant Application Deadline: Friday, March 9, 5pm

Grant Awards: \$1500-\$5,000

Grant Guidelines:

1) Community Oriented: Proposals should address one of the following community needs, and be accessible to a broad spectrum of community members.

Creative Education: To support creativity for all ages in our community and school programs that encourage teaching, learning and experiencing the arts.

Artist-in-Residencies: To support artist in residency programs in all disciplines that encourage the creation, presentation and sharing of art in Jackson.

Art Experiences: Festivals, temporary events, art gatherings/happenings, temporary installations.

Storytelling: Giving voice to the stories that connect and inspire us.

2) Collaborations: We encourage collaborations, with each participating non-profit organization playing a substantial and specific role in the partnership.

3) Vibrant and Wonder-inspiring: We value the transformative power of wonder, collaboration, and the creative process. We empower our creative community to take artistic risks and contribute to a vibrant arts culture.

All applicants must be a 501(c)(3) designated organization or be fiscally sponsored by one. At least one applicant organization must have a mission that promotes culture or the arts in Jackson Hole. The project must be relevant to Teton County, Wyoming.

A 1:1 cash match is required of all projects.

Grant Documentation:

Applicants will be asked to prepare for the Grant Application: (1) Project Narrative, (2) Budget Template, (3) Project Outcome, (4) Timeline for Completion and (5) Organization's Financial Budget. Applications can be found at: www.centerofwonder.org.

Center of Wonder grantees are asked to attend up to three process meetings with a Wonder coordinator:

- 1. If the grant committee has questions or needs more information about the proposed project, or feasibility of its timeline, a preliminary meeting before grant approval may be requested.**
- 2. A mid-process report between all organizational point people and Center of Wonder is required. The date and time of this report will be determined based on the time frame of the project but will occur at least 4 weeks prior to the project's completion.**
- 3. A final evaluation meeting and report is required. This meeting will occur no more than 30 days after the project's completion and will include the final grant report, and documentation of project expenses. These meetings will be designed to evaluate the overall success of the project.**
