Working artists must demonstrate a proven commitment to the advancement of arts and culture in Jackson through a recent body of work in the visual arts, performing arts or literary arts. The objective of the application is to illustrate your commitment to a life in the arts; the content and relative quality of an applicant's creative work will not be judged.

Artists engaged in the following disciplines will be considered:

Visual Arts: painting, printmaking, sculpture, photography, ceramics, woodworking, architecture/design, media arts, film, and new media.

Performing Arts: dance, theater, and music.

Literary Arts: fiction, non-fiction, poetry and spoken word.

Submittal Requirements:

-Housing Trust application attached. Note: applicants must meet the income and asset requirements detailed on the application.

-Artist statement. Please address the following questions in your statement:

- What is your art form or medium?
- Describe any formal education or training pertinent to your artwork.
- Do you teach within your field of creative work?
- What percentage of your income is currently derived from your creative work? What plans do you have for generating income from your creative work in the future?
- What other creative work have you done in our community? (non-profits, creative industry)
- Describe any volunteer work you do in the arts community.
- Why are you interested in living at Redmond St?

-Evidence of a recent body of work, demonstrated by an artist resume or CV that lists dates and locations of exhibitions, publications, performances or press; Please include documentation of artwork, including image files, video clips, or writing samples;

-3 letters of recommendation or support from peers and/or professionals in the arts.
